

ORDINANCE NO. 07 - 2024

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEREA, KENTUCKY, VACATING AND CLOSING A CERTAIN PLATTED RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF BEREA, KENTUCKY, PROVIDING ACCESS TO AND FROM NEELY STREET.

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the request of Andrew Tolliver, Hannah Tolliver, William O. Lowder and Theresa B. Lowder, being all of the property owners in or abutting the portion of thirty-foot (30') right-of-way, as described on Exhibit A attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the thirty-foot (30') right-of-way appears on a plat recorded in the Office of the Madison County Clerk in Plat Book 7, page 369;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that (1) all of the property owners abutting the right-of-way to be closed have requested this closure; (2) written notice has been sent to Andrew Tolliver, Hannah Tolliver, William O. Lowder and Theresa B. Lowder, being all of the property owner in or abutting the portion of the thirty-foot (30') right-of-way to be closed; and (3) all property owners in or abutting the right-of-way being closed have given written consent; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the public interest of the City of Berea would be advanced by closing the thirty-foot (30') right-of-way as described in the attachment hereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Berea, Kentucky, does ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE

The following described thirty-foot (30') right-of-way in the City of Berea, Kentucky be and is hereby closed:

The right-of-way to be closed, and the property to be combined with the abutting property owner, is described on the attached Exhibit A.

SECTION TWO

Pursuant to KRS 82.405, and the findings of fact set out in the preamble to this Ordinance, the right of way described in Section One of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby CLOSED AND VACATED, and the land delineated in the right-of-way shall revert to the abutting property owners as shown on Exhibit A.

SECTION THREE

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall be recorded in the Office of the Madison County Clerk and be published according to law.

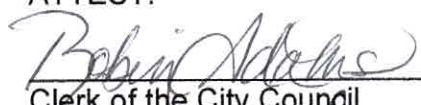

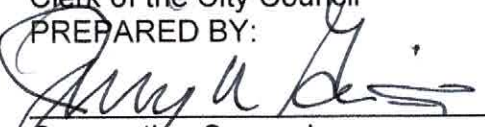
